2024 Women's Leadership Program

\$25,000 | Industry-Exclusive Sponsorship | June 2024 - May 2025

Women's Leadership Program empowers women at all stages in their careers with the skills and network they need to excel in their own careers and to create the conditions for other women to thrive. In a nine-month program, presented in partnership with Simmons University Institute for Inclusive Leadership, 120 participants learn vital tools such as finding their leadership style, navigating gender dynamics at work, perceptions, public managing speaking, negotiation, networking, and team management. In addition, participants are integrated into the Chamber's Women's Network and Individual Action Project at their own complete an organizations.

Notable outcomes from the Class of 2022-2023:

- 76% are highly skilled in identifying and flexing their leadership style (compared to 8% at the start of the program)
- 66% are highly skilled in creating inclusive cultures (compared to 24% at the start of the program)
- 61% are highly skilled in leading teams (compared to 27% at the start of the program)
- 44 Net Promoter Score

MARKETING & PROMOTION

- Company logo and link to be included in Chamber's monthly e-calendar and on website, which averages 21,400 visitors per month.

LIVE PRESENCE (VIRTUAL OR ONSITE)

- A representative from the sponsor company has opportunity to provide welcome comments at several key sessions throughout the program, including the opening (orientation) and the closing (graduation).

- Sponsor may select two participants for the program with their acceptance guaranteed. This is a \$11,000 value/rate of tuition. Company may offer these slots to other organizations as scholarships if no female staff wish to participate.
